

Students on Governing Boards

The Shaw Island School Mission includes promoting students with responsibility, integrity and civility. This policy supports the district mission as it encourages student leadership. Serving as a student representative to the Shaw Island School Board would enhance the knowledge base of the student regarding the running of a school district, policies, procedures, and budgeting. It would encourage personal growth in leadership and responsibility as the student would receive input and act as a liaison between the board and the student body. The position of student representative would create an avenue of youth communications as another part of community and school working together. To foster this relationship with students, the board may annually seat up to two student representatives as advisory non-voting members of the board.

Student representatives on the board may attend all meetings. The student members will contribute to board discussion by providing insight and perspective, serve as a liaison for the associated student body, and report to students about the work of the board and district activities. Student representatives will not attend executive sessions, make motions, or hold board offices.
